However, for many of our children, being able to enjoy a hot meal at school isn't possible without a functional community kitchen. We believe in feeding our students bodies in order to support learning. Because of this, we will also be raising the paddle to start a Nutritious Meal Program. By supporting this effort, you will be contributing to a kitchen remodel and helping to fund items to start a lunch program where our students may enjoy hot, nutritious meals during the school day. Our K-8 students annually committed to serving the community with our partners at:

Trick or Treat for UNICEF - HFBCS students collect an average of \$500 annually on Halloween night to support children in need around the world.

Earth Corps - Students working to help and learn about the environment. During the 4-5 hour day, our 4th - 8th graders mulch, plant, and weed invasive plants at a local park. Our students learn about the ecosystem and storm water pollution.

Salvation Army - Our 8th graders annually serves Dinner and plan a Christmas party for the people in need.

St. Vincent De Paul - Students routinely visit St. Vincent De Paul to help sort and stacked dry and can goods, and distributing food to the community.

Buddy Program - Our 5th to 8th grade students partnered- up and read to the younger students and help watch over them during the weekly Mass.
