Notes and reminders

- **NEW! Uniform reminders:** We will be beginning a campaign to enforce dress code expectations beginning the week after Easter break. As you prepare for return to school, please make sure students are meeting the following expectations. - Shoes must be black, brown, navy or white with logos no larger than a quarter. Shoes with lights are not allowed. - Students must wear only Dennis-issued sweaters and sweatshirts or navy blue sweaters or hoodies with no logo. Green Holy Family and Waskowitz sweatshirts must be worn only on Tuesdays. - Spirit shirts may be worn on Tuesdays only. - Hats and hoods are permitted only at recess. - Accessories should be neutral in color or the colors of the uniform. This includes hair accessories and jewelry. Stud earrings and small drop earrings are allowed. - Middle school girls may wear light makeup only. They may not bring makeup to school. False eyelashes and nails are not allowed. - Nails may be painted in neutral colors only (clear, white, light pink). Thank you for your help with this!
